Process for Registration of UFV course and Dual Credit:

Secondary school students may take concurrent studies at UFV while still working toward secondary school graduation, under the following guidelines: The GWG student must:

1. be a full time student attending GW Graham, and is in the program-appropriate grade.
2. have written parent or legal guardian approval provided to the GWG Counselor.
3. complete and submit a copy of UFV “Application Package” to the GWG counselor (more details of requirements in the application package)
4. submit the original “Application Package” at the [UFV Registrar’s Admissions office](#) on the UFV campus in Chilliwack (**by the stated deadlines** as it varies per program, and it is the STUDENT’s responsibility to meet that deadline) along with UFV \$45 application fee.
