We have been working hard this summer on planning for the 2020/2021 school year, and I am pleased to be able to share the plan with you. I am aware that these uncertain times, along with announcements from the Ministry of Education, as well as hearing some tentative plans from other school districts leaves you guessing at how the school year will look for G.W. Graham Secondary School. Our school administration team has been working with the secondary school administration teams from Sardis Secondary and Chilliwack Secondary to come up with an overall plan for all secondary schools in the Chilliwack School District. We have worked closely with our District Health and Safety Team, and are now going over site specific protocols with the G.W. Graham Health and Safety Team. We are working with the entire G.W. Graham staff and going over many details to ensure that all students are supported with excellent learning opportunities this year.

The most significant structural change is our move away from the traditional four-block daily schedule for two semesters, to a one-block daily schedule over eight, five-week sections. The one-block daily schedule results in staff and students primarily working in cohorts of 25 – 30 students, well below the 120-student cohort constraint set by the Ministry of Education. We have also sectioned the school into four sections with designated entrances and staggered lunches in order to decrease the number of daily interactions with students and staff. Please read the
